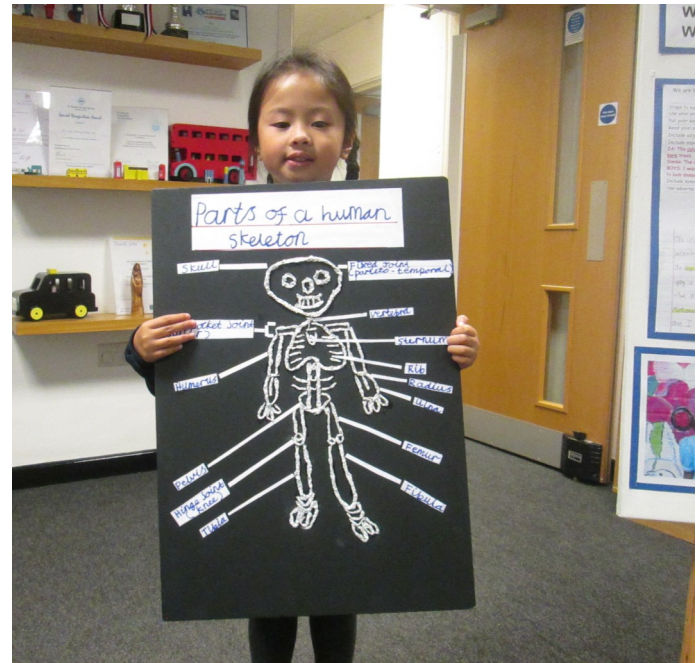
### Holiday homework...
