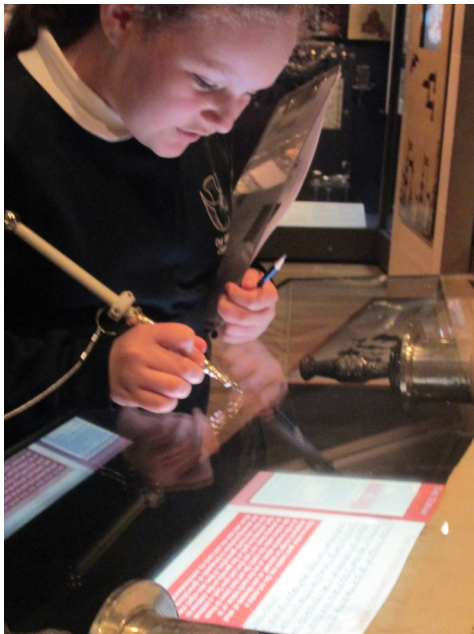
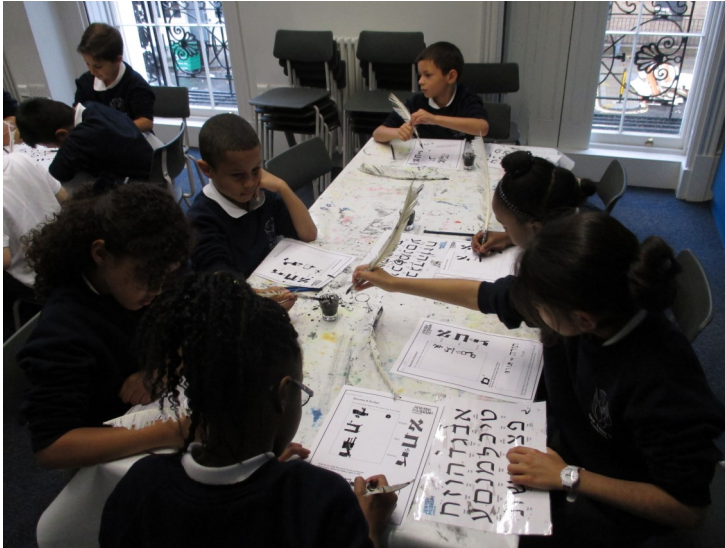

Friday 19th December—Children break up at 3.30pm for the Christmas Holiday



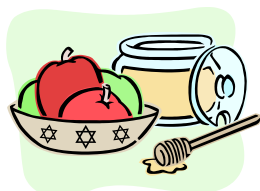
Work of the week...
