Congratulations to our Year 6 class for winning the attendance award for this week.

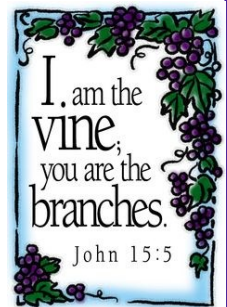
Our attendance should be at least 95%. Please make sure your child is in school every single day unless they are very ill indeed.
