**Our attendance is too low in Year 2 and Year 1.**

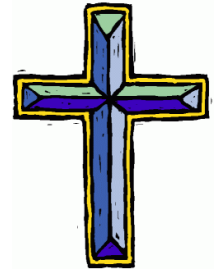
Congratulations to our Year 4 class for winning the attendance award for this week.
