Our attendance is too low in Year 6, Year 2 and Reception.

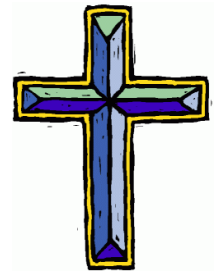
Congratulations to our Year 4 class for winning the attendance award for this week.

Year 2	91.11%

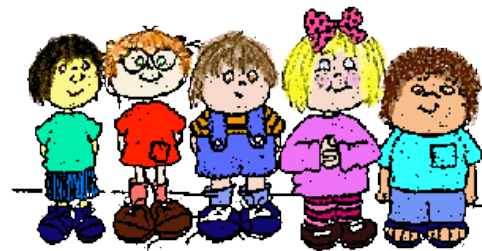
Our Prayer...
