When we think about the words Go shine in the world we are thinking about how we follow Jesus' example.

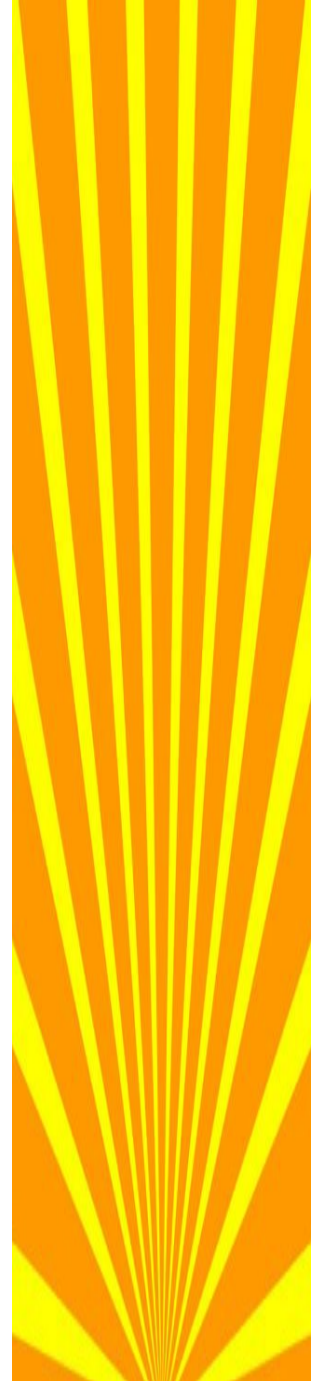
For example, at our school, we are kind to each other.
