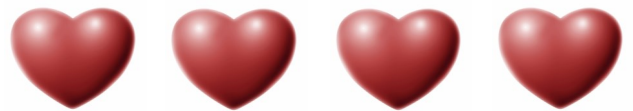
Healthy Heart Day...
