On Sunday we will hear from the Gospel of St Mark, when Jesus cures the leper.

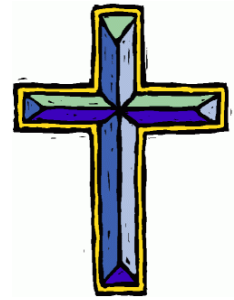
Jesus,

Lord graciously hear us.

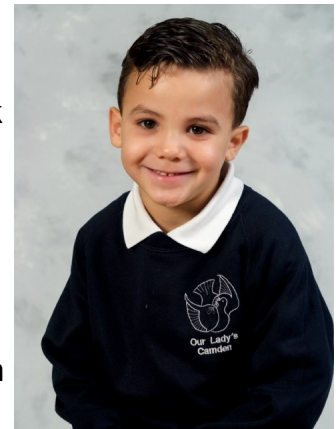


Work of the week...

Every week a fantastic piece of children's work is showcased in the school lobby (next to the office).

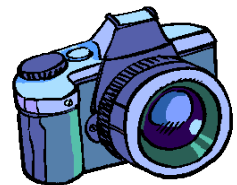
