£2.00 CHILD TICKET includes admittance, entertainment, one portion of BBQ food, a portion of salad and a soft drink

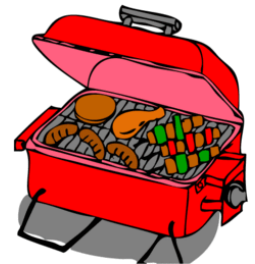
Tickets can be purchased from the school office or Friends of Our Lady's (PTFA) members in the school playground.

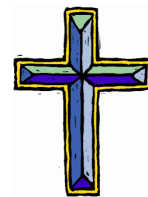
