In Sunday's Gospel we will hear about Jesus challenging a wealthy man whose love of money and possessions were stopping him from finding true happiness.

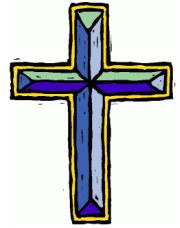
Faith is our greatest treasure!
